Dress Standards

General

Proper attire is expected and required for all members and guests. Members are encouraged to consider common sense and respect the comfort level of fellow Members when making attire decisions. It is anticipated that both men and women will use good judgment and dress appropriately based upon the degree of formality established for each of the Club's activity and dining areas. Dress standards apply throughout the Club, including the golf course and practice areas. A person not dressed per Club rules may be asked to obtain and change into the proper clothing at the time observed or may be denied Club access. Apart from the locker rooms, golf shop, and fitness center, at no time shall men wear hats or caps in the clubhouse.

General (Continued)

Shirts must be tucked in. No tee shirts, slogan shirts, workout or exercise clothes, or athletic wear are allowed in the clubhouse after 11:00 am.

Members are responsible for the appropriate dress of their family and guests. If at any time you are questioning your attire, we encourage you to please check with Member Services prior to your arrival to avoid any issues.

Dining

The Aquidneck Club “Casual Attire” standard applies to adults and children and is in effect in the Great Hall, Bar, Enclosed Porch, and Dining Room.

“Smart Casual” attire is required in the dining room Friday and Saturday evenings after 5:00 pm.

- Tucked in golf or polo shirt; collared or dress collarless shirt
- Collared or tailored shirts that are designed to be worn untucked
 - Tailored dress jeans with no rips or frays
- Golf or Bermuda style shorts (no shorter than 5 inches above the knee)
- Flip flops and open toed sandals are not permitted for men during Smart Casual times

Golf

- Shirts must be collared and tucked in
- Hats must be worn facing forward. This also applies to the driving range and practice areas
- Hats are not permitted while in the clubhouse, except in the locker rooms and golf shop.

Tennis

- Tennis shoes or approved athletic shoes are required to be on the courts
- For women: tennis skirts, tennis shorts, or tennis dress of an appropriate length is required
- For men: tennis shorts, athletic pants, collared shirt, or collarless athletic shirt is required
- Hats and visors must be worn facing forward

Pool

Bathing attire shall be worn tastefully and be deemed suitable for a family environment, with appropriate coverage for all bathers. Bathing suits are not permitted anywhere within the clubhouse, except the pool area and locker rooms. When exiting the pool area or on the dining terrace, either a shirt or bathing suit cover-up must be worn.

Fitness

- Shirts and sneakers must be worn at all times
- Tee shirts, tank tops, gym shorts, and warm up pants are acceptable

Dog Policy

Dogs are not permitted on the golf course, practice range, putting greens, or in club golf carts. Dog walking is only permitted on the roadway from the clubhouse to the lookout. Dogs must be leashed at all times. Dogs are not permitted in the dining room or any dining area. only ADA approved service animals are permitted in dining areas. Emotional support animals are not permitted.
